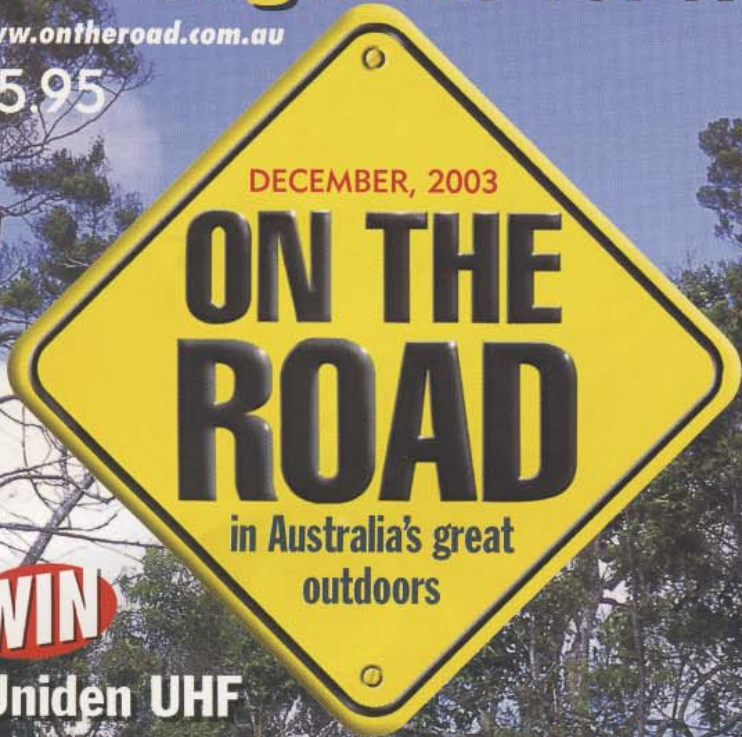


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Greatest Aussie meat pie

THIRD-generation master bakers Bill, Robert and Tony Stevenson of Dubbo in NSW, have won the 14th Great Aussie Meat Pie Competition.

The Village Hot Bake Bakery Café Dubbo won 10 medals in the fiercely-contested event, with mouth-watering gourmet flavors such as Beef Bacon & Chilli, Honey Soy and Lamb, and Veal with Marsala.

The Stevensons use traditional pie-baking methods free of premixes, with some recipes dating back to 1918.



Located at 113 Darling Street in Dubbo, the bakery café has for years attracted travelling tourists and visitors hungry to sample the 250 pies, cakes and pastries on offer.

In addition to their retail outlet in Dubbo, their products are available throughout the central west of NSW in schools, corner stores

supermarkets and service stations. In the 14th Great Aussie Pie Competition, pie-makers from all over Australia sent 1450 pies to be scrutinised by 13 judges over a five-day period.
